Director's Message

When I explain what SafeSpot Children's Advocacy Center (CAC) is, I find it easier to explain what children face *without* one on their side. When a child is abused, they often endure pain and trauma that is unthinkable. Imagine having to repeatedly recount such unspeakable exploitation to police, child protection workers, lawyers, nurses, and doctors. Perhaps with each story, memories become jumbled as the body works hard to repress the hurt. The chances of being believed are diminishing rapidly, but the chances for PTSD are taking a sharp rise. This is the path of a child without a Children's Advocacy Center in their corner.

Fortunately SafeSpot's platform is based upon the latest in CAC models and our ability to serve the growing demand has rapidly increased. In part, this is thanks to the renewed partnerships with Fairfax County Department of Family Services and the Fairfax County Commonwealth's Attorney. SafeSpot now offers longer hours, more staff, and additional training needed for the recent 12% increase in referrals from law enforcement and Social Services.

Throughout the month of April, you may see blue pinwheels at your library, school or place of worship. The pinwheel is a symbol of child abuse prevention and is used to raise awareness for survivors. Please show your support as well, by donning blue ribbons or displaying blue pinwheels! SafeSpot CAC will be hosting several awareness events in our community and would love for you and your family to join us!

Please do not forget the importance of protecting our children in Fairfax County!
