I hope this note finds you healthy and in good spirits. Today marks the beginning of National Child Abuse Prevention Month, a time dedicated to raising awareness about the prevalence of child abuse and the importance of families and communities working together to prevent abuse and neglect. I encourage you to join us on social media this month to learn the facts and help spread the word. You can also show your



support of child survivors by displaying pinwheels at your office or home throughout the month (see below for details).

I am also pleased to share our 2021 Impact Report and Video. Last year we felt the full affect of our community's return to "normal". SafeSpot saw a 26% increase in the number of children referred for forensic interviews and support services last year, highlighting the critical role of mandatory reporters such as teachers, coaches, medical and mental health professionals, and child care providers. According to a report by the Office of the Administration for Children and Families, Children's Bureau educators are the #1 source of child abuse reports, representing 21% of all reports in 2019. When our schools closed due to the pandemic in 2020, reports of child abuse fell across the country with only the most severe cases coming to light. While there are many reasons to be thankful that our children are back in the classroom, our increased ability to identify and stop abuse is foremost in my mind. I encourage you to read through the report and join us in celebrating all we were able to achieve as a community for vulnerable children and their families last year.

Finally, I want to personally invite you to join us on Friday, May13th for the return of the Passion for Fashion Fundraiser. After a 2-year hiatus this fabulous event is back - and it is going to be better than ever!
